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Accreditation rules

- Classes are organized in two semesters with 30 credits per semester
- Maximum 5 subjects per semester (more only exceptional)
- Minimum 3 ECTS and maximum 10 ECTS credits per subjects
- At least 50% of direct teaching, of which part can be research work

Accreditation rules



- Basic 10% of cases,
- Disciplinary or professional 20%
- Narrowly disciplinary 20% of cases,
- Complementary, 5%
- General 5% of cases.

- Minimum number of students for the elective course is 5
- The scope of direct teaching is between 20 and 25 hours per week

Accreditation rules

Study programs must differentiate from each other by at least 35% of the total number of ECTS credits, in order for them to be to be considered as a different study programs, where these 35% are made of groups of disciplinary and narrow disciplinary subjects. In this percentage are also included elective courses or ECTS value of elective courses.

In other words: orientations in the study program can not vary more than 35%, otherwise they represent different study program


