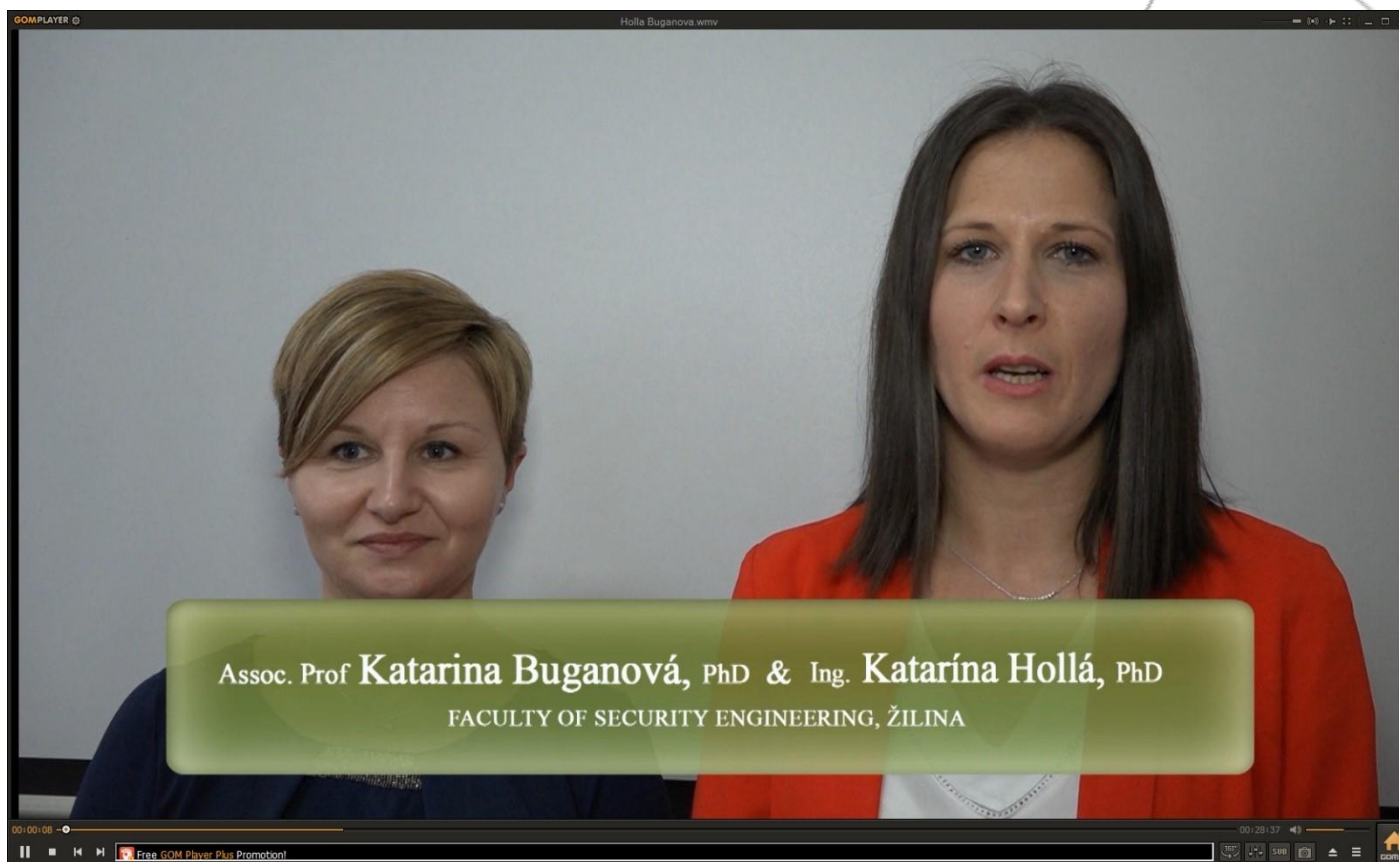

Contact with guests

Determine a contact person.

Ask the guests to prepare:

- ✓ *Written version of the lecture with questions, and the PowerPoint presentation, and*
- ✓ *Subtitles and webinar PowerPoint presentation.*

Send the address and explain how to get there.

Agree about the date and time of the event.

Ask them not to wear anything that wrinkles easily or has stripes or dots.

Remind them to send the required material.

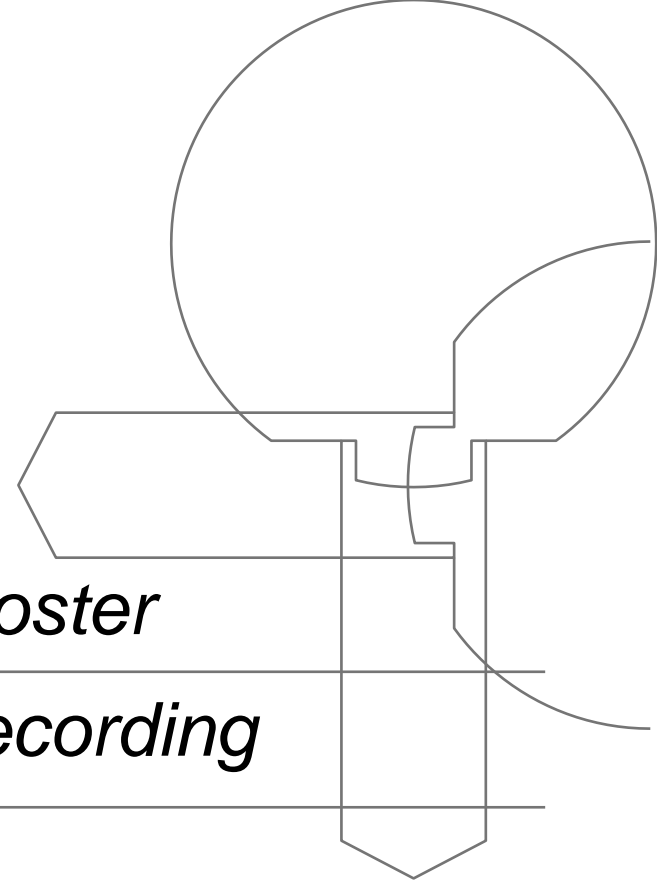


Pre-recording phase

- ✓ *Room selection*
- ✓ *K-FORCE roll-up banner or poster*

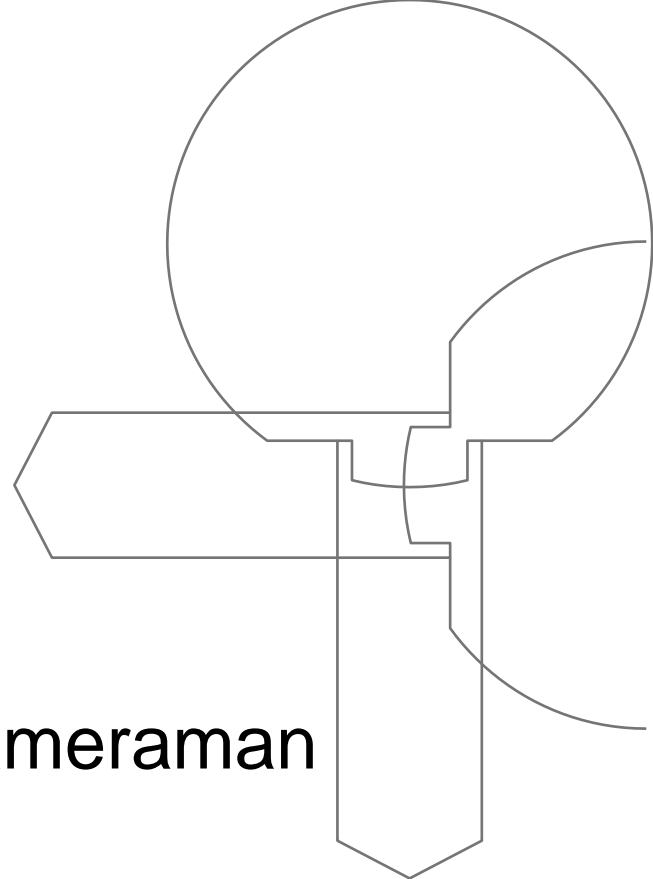
- ✓ *Inform occupants about the recording*

- ✓ *Wi-Fi password*
- ✓ *Provide refreshments, snacks and medicaments*



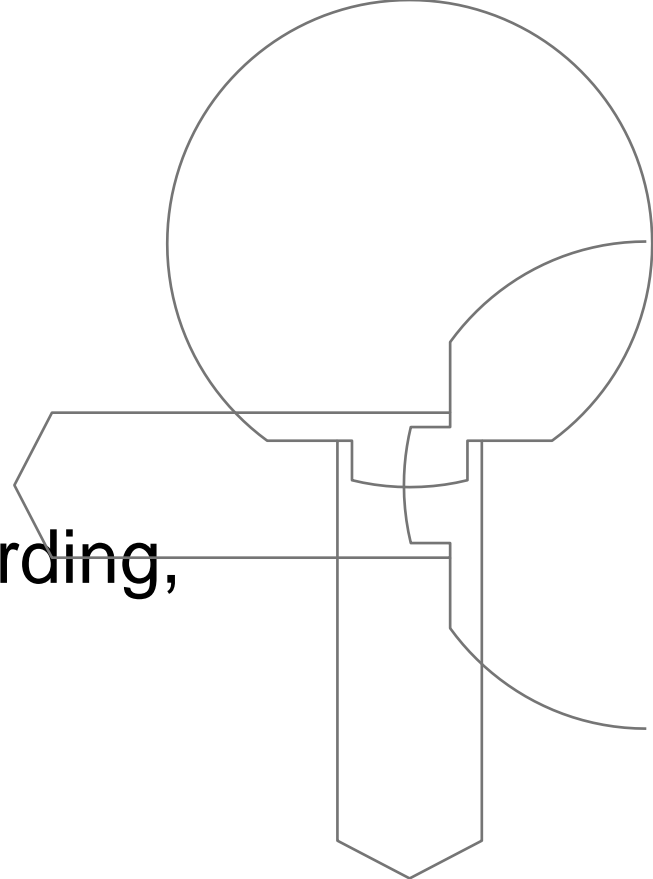
Recording

- ✓ Make the recording as simple as possible
- ✓ Engage a skilful and patient cameraman



Post-production

- ✓ Save time and money – find one person who can do the recording, editing and subtitling.
- ✓ Set deadlines.
- ✓ Make sure you have a replacement for the cameraman.

- ✓ **Investigative and forensic** context



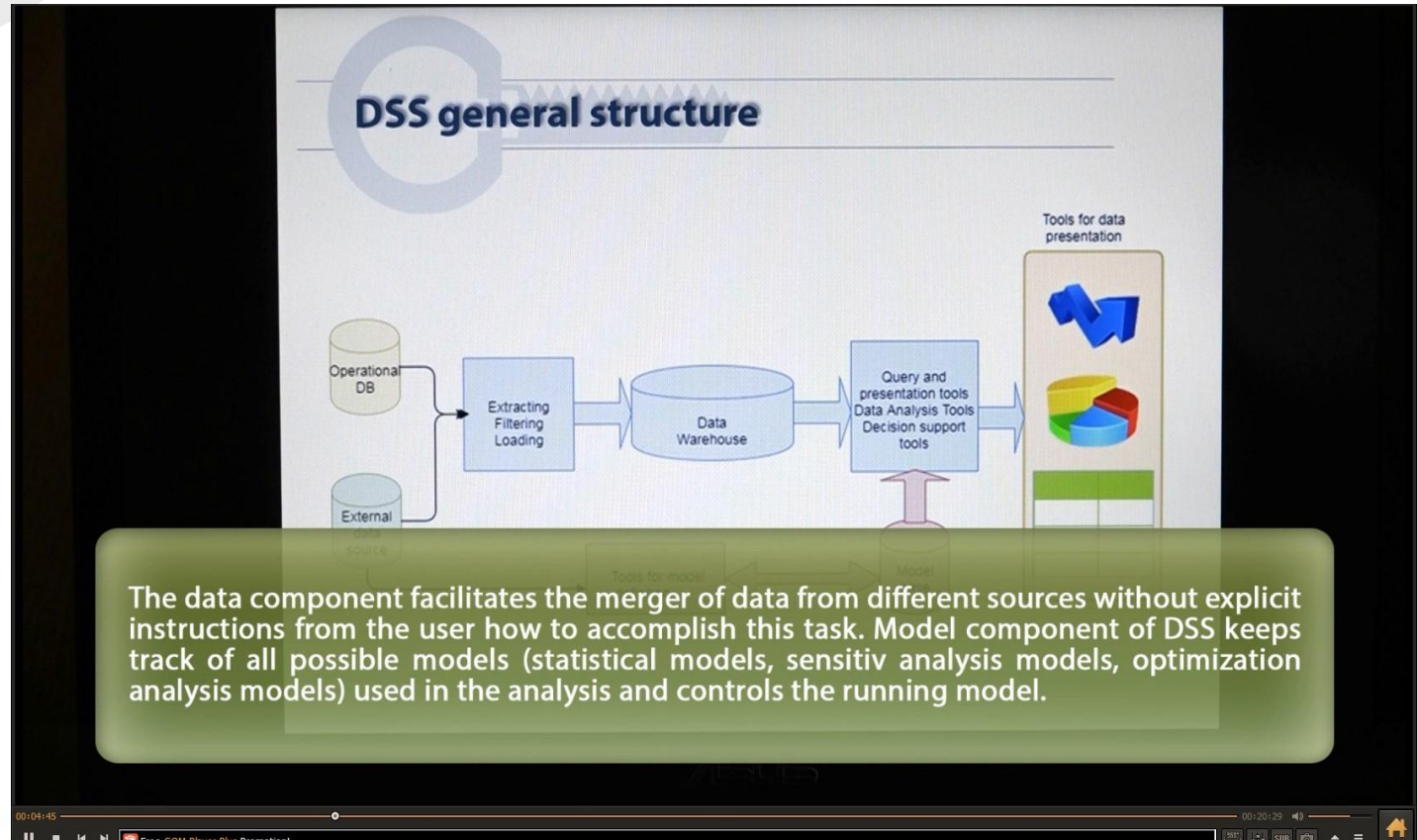
RISK COMMUNICATION?

- ✓ Phrase "risk communication" first appeared in 1984
- ✓ **exchange of information** about risks
- ✓ key to risk communication success:
anticipation, preparation, and practice
- ✓ **ISO 31000** (Communication and consultation):
"continual and iterative processes that an organization conducts to provide, share or obtain information and to engage in dialogue with stakeholders regarding the management of risk"

Crisis management implies a need for a rapid response to very complex challenges, informing and information dissemination, but also protection against consequences of panic or other forms of behavior that can lead to "secondary hazards", or risk consequences escalation due to inadequate communication.
